

Crop Insurance Policies & Programs for Specialty Crop Growers

Here's a quick list of some of the crop insurance policies & programs that horticulture producers & specialty crop growers can utilize to protect their crops & farming operations:

MULTI-PERIL CROP INSURANCE (MPCI)

- Protects against loss due to natural perils, living threats, and losses in revenue
- 39 specialty crops in KY with individual policies
- Coverage varies by crop and by county

WHOLE FARM REVENUE PROTECTION (WFRP)

- Insures revenue based on past tax documents instead of yield history
- Individual commodity losses are not considered, just the overall farm revenue losses
- Great for diverse operations growing crops without specific coverage

Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP)

- Financial assistance to growers of any crop with no available crop insurance
- Protects against losses caused by damaging weather events, natural events, and any problems that arise from those events

WFRP MICRO-FARM POLICY

- Specially designed for direct-marketing farms
- Less than \$350,000 in approved revenue required
- Less reporting required!

TREE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TAP)

- Available to nursery tree growers and orchardists
- Financial assistance to replant trees, bushes, and vines lost to natural disaster
 - Ornamental, fruit, nut, and Christmas trees
 - Excludes timber trees
